The House and Senate Budget Committees have differing interpretations of the emergency designation for certain accounts in P.L. 111-212. The House interpretation is incorporated in the nonemergency amounts of this table. The table excludes the 2011 scoring for emergencies in the 2010 enacted supplementals (BA: \$3,217 million, outlays: \$26,314 million).
