S. 1317 would transfer administrative jurisdiction of 98 acres of federal land in Arizona from the Forest Service to the National Park Service (NPS). That land would become part of the Sunset Crater Volcano National Monument.

The affected parcel contains maintenance facilities, park housing, and a visitor center currently managed by the NPS under an interagency agreement. CBO expects that those uses would remain unchanged after the transfer; thus, we estimate that any administrative costs to implement S. 1317 would be insignificant over the 2022-2026 period. Any spending would be subject to the availability of appropriated funds.
