H.R. 4404 would direct the Department of the Interior to study a segment of the Kissimmee River in Florida for potential addition to the National Wild and Scenic Rivers System. Based on the costs of similar studies, CBO estimates that implementing H.R. 4404 would cost less than \$500,000 over the 2022-2026 period; any spending would be subject to the availability of appropriated funds.
