H.R. 6142 would direct the National Park Service (NPS) to study the feasibility of designating a 1,454-mile trail system in Ohio as the Buckeye National Scenic Trail.

Using information from the NPS and the cost of similar studies, CBO estimates that implementing H.R. 6142 would cost less than \$500,000 over the 2022-2027 period; any spending would be subject to the availability of appropriated funds.
