The Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010 establishes budget-reporting and enforcement procedures for legislation affecting direct spending or revenues. The net changes in outlays that are subject to those procedures are shown here.

The bill would authorize the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to provide additional education benefits to students pursuing training under the Veterans Rapid Retraining Assistance Program if their training is disrupted because the training provider stopped operating or VA disapproved the training program.
