S. 3434 would require the Department of Commerce to contract with the National Academy of Public Administration to complete a study on manufacturing programs operated by the department, including options to consolidate the programs under a new administrative entity.

Using information from the Department of Commerce, CBO estimates that it would cost \$2 million, including employee and contracting costs, to complete the study. Such spending would be subject to the availability of appropriated funds.
