H.R. 7946 would permit deported foreign nationals who served in the U.S. Armed Forces to return to the United States as lawful permanent residents. The bill also would allow foreign nationals serving in the U.S. Armed Forces to naturalize (become a U.S. citizen) more quickly. Finally, the bill would enable some foreign nationals whose family members are U.S. service members or veterans to become lawful permanent residents more quickly.
